



The Cave: Mumford and Sons

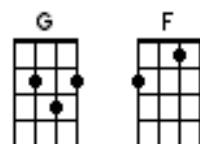
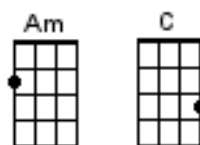
Intro: Once through first verse
